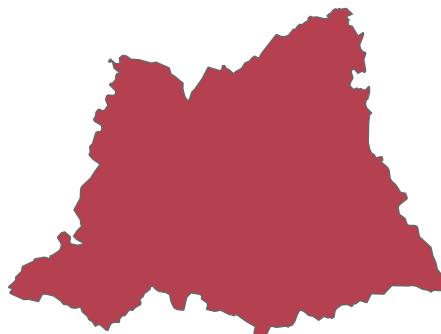

## What this Factsheet Contains

India has committed to accomplishing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by 2030. We provide a status report for 707 districts of India for **33 SDG indicators** that cover 9 of the 17 official SDGs related to the **Population Health** and **Social Determinants of Health**. The data for this assessment comes from two rounds of the National Family Health Survey (NFHS) conducted in 2016 and 2021. This Factsheet is based on the analysis published in Subramanian, S. V. et al (2023) Progress on Sustainable Development Goal indicators in 707 districts of India: a quantitative mid-line assessment using the National Family Health Surveys, 2016 and 2021. **The Lancet Regional Health-Southeast Asia**. <https://doi.org/10.1016/j.lansea.2023.100155>

## Summary

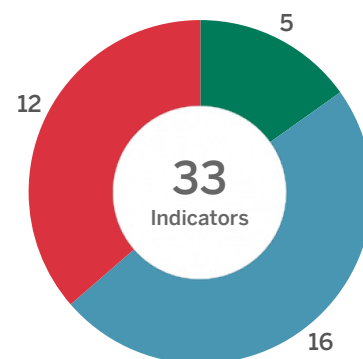
Ranking based on Percentage of SDG Indicators showing **Achieved (I & II)** and **On-Target** (out of 707 Districts)

## Notes

**Achieved-I:** have already met the SDG target by 2021 and have either observed an improvement between 2016 and 2021 or a worsening small enough in magnitude between 2016 and 2021 such that the Achieved status is maintained by 2030.

**Achieved-II:** have already met the SDG target by 2021 but have observed a worsening magnitude of change between 2016 and 2021. If this trend continues, the Achieved status will be undone by 2030.

**On-Target:** have not met the SDG target by 2021 and have observed a magnitude of improvement between 2016 and 2021 sufficient to meet the target by 2030.

**Off-Target:** have not met the SDG target by 2021 and either observed worsening between 2016 and 2021 or observed an insufficient magnitude of improvement between 2016 and 2021. If these trends continue, the targets will not be met by 2030.

**District (2021):** shows the estimated prevalence for the SDG indicators from NFHS-5 microdata.

**District Change (2021-2016):** shows the percentage point difference in estimated prevalence for the SDG indicators between NFHS-5 and NFHS-4.
